FIRST ESTATE



CLERGY

- 130,000 people, 0.5% o the population
- . Owned 10% of the land
- . Did not have to pay the taille

SECOND ESTATE



NOBILITY

- 350,000 people, 2% of the population
- Owned 25 to 30% of the land
- . Did not have to pay the taille

THIRD ESTATE



PEASANTS, WORKERS, BOURGEOISIE (MIDDLE CLASS

- More than 26 million people, 97% of the population
- Owned about 60% of the land
- Paid the faille

- Napoleon returns to France but is defeated Waterloo in 1815
