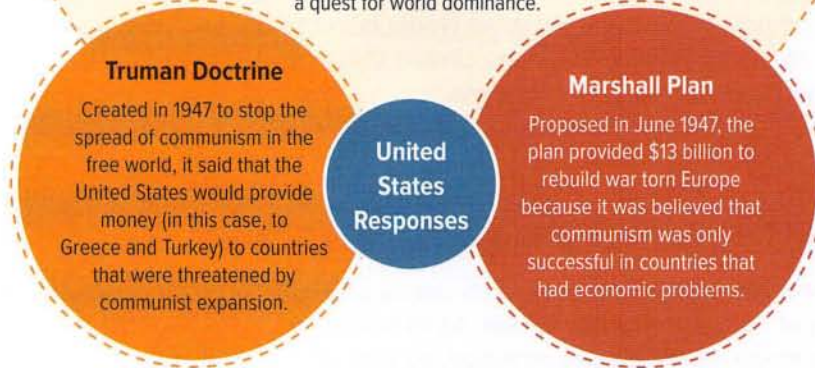


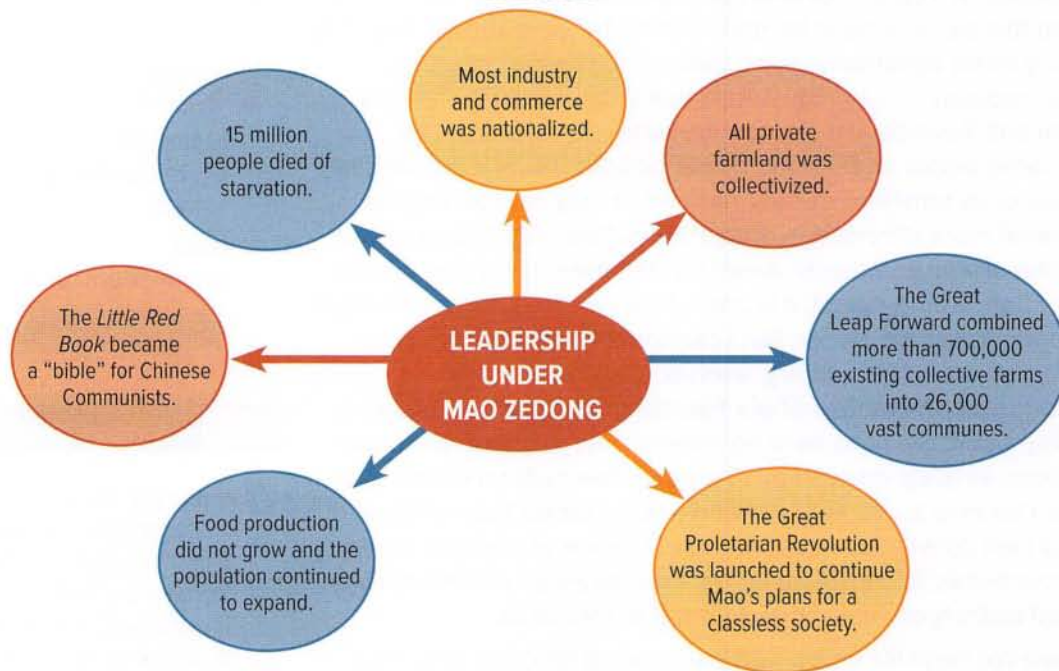

THE COLD WAR LESSON 1

After World War II, the differences between the **United States** and the **Soviet Union** caused the two countries to come into conflict. The Soviets feared the capitalist West, and Western leaders feared communism. Thus began the **Cold War**, not a conventional war fought with weapons, but a war of political ideologies and a quest for world dominance.
